

Mr Skinny



Mr Skinny is made using double knitting acrylic yarn in yellow, green, black and red, with a 3.5mm hook. He is around 35cm high. He has 9mm safety eyes.

MR = Magic Ring

BLO = Back Loop Only

FLO = Front Loop Only

SS = Slip Stitch

FO = Fasten Off

** = Repeat This Section

As we have different names for stitches in Britain and America, I thought I would write out a double crochet to make sure we are all stitching the same thing. :@)

Yarn over the hook and push the hook into a stitch.
Yarn over the hook and draw up a loop (3 loops left on the hook)
Yarn over and draw yarn through 2 loops on the hook (2 loops left on the hook)
Yarn over and draw yarn through both loops on the hook
Ta da!

Body - Yellow

Rnd 1 sc 6 in MR (6)
Rnd 2 2sc in each st (12)
Rnd 3 *2sc in next st, sc in next st* (18)
Rnd 4 – 43 sc in each st (18)
Attach safety eyes
Rnd 44 *sc2tog, sc in next st* (12)
Rnd 45 sc2tog around (6)
FO

Hat - Red

Rnd 1 sc 6 in MR
Rnd 2 2sc in each st (12)
Rnd 3 BLO, sc in each st (12)
Rnd 4 sc in each st (12)
Rnd 5 sc in next 5 sts, sc2tog, sc in next 5 sts (11)
Rnd 6 sc in next 2 sts, sc2tog, sc in next 2 sts, sc2tog, sc in next 3 sts (9)
Rnd 7 sc in next 3 sts, sc2tog, sc in next 4 sts (8)
Rnd 8 sc in next 2 sts, sc2tog, sc in next 4 sts (7)
Rnd 9 sc in next 4 sts, sc2tog, sc in next st (6)
Rnd 10 sc in next 2 sts, sc2tog, sc in next 2 sts (5)
Rnd 11 sc in each st (5)
Rnd 12 FLO, sc in each st (5)
Rnd 13 3sc in each st (15)
Rnd 14 *2sc in next st, sc in next st,* sc in next st (22)
SS, FO leaving a long tail to fasten hat to body

Nose - Green

Rnd 1 sc 6 in MR (6)
Rnd 2 sc in each st (6)
SS, FO, leave a long tail to attach the nose to the body

Arm

Rnd 1 sc 8 in MR (8)
Rnd 2 sc in each st (8)
Rnd 3 sc2tog, sc in next 2 sts, sc2tog, sc in next 2 sts (6)

Rnd 4 sc2tog, sc in next st, sc2tog, sc in next st (4)

Rnd 5 – 7 sc in each st (4)

FO

Fingers

Make 8

Rnd 1 sc 3 in MR (3)

Rnd 2 sc in each st (3)

FO

Feet

Rnd 1 sc 6 in MR (6)

Rnd 2 2sc in each st (12)

Rnd 3 2DC in next st, DC in next st, 2DC in next st, DC in next st, sc in next 8 sts (14)

Rnd 4 sc in each st (14)

Rnd 5 sc in next st, (sc2tog) x 3, sc in next 2 sts, (sc2tog) x 2, sc in next st (9)

Rnd 6 (sc2tog) x 4, sc in next (5)

Rnd 7 – 14 sc in each st (5)

SS, FO

Finishing

Stitch on the nose

Stitch the fingers to the arms

Stitch the arms to the body

Sew on the hat. Bring the end from the brim through to where the brim joins the hat and then stitch down so the brim is free and not sewn down

Stitch on the legs

Sew on the mouth either using backstitch or a large fly stitch
